Dr. Nikos Mylonopoulos is Associate Professor of Information Systems, at ALBA Graduate Business School. He teaches information systems strategy and management, electronic business, and IT outsourcing. Over the last several years, he collaborates with the Center of Advanced Learning Technologies at INSEAD on the development of computer-based simulation games for teaching crisis management, collaboration, change management and complex decision-making more effectively. He holds a B.Sc. from the Athens University of Economics and Business and a Ph.D. from Warwick Business School. He has taught at both these Schools and also at the University of London (Birkbeck College) and the Loughborough University Business School. He is a Visiting Professor of Electronic Commerce at BEM, the Bordeaux School of Management. He has designed and delivered executive seminars to multinationals and national corporations. He has co-edited two books, "Organizations as Knowledge Systems" with H. Tsoukas, and "Social and Economic Transformation in the Digital Era" with G. Doukidis and N. Pouloudi.
